



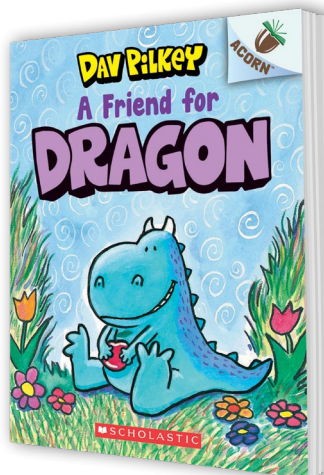

Dragon is a humble hero with a heart of gold, and he always helps those who need him.



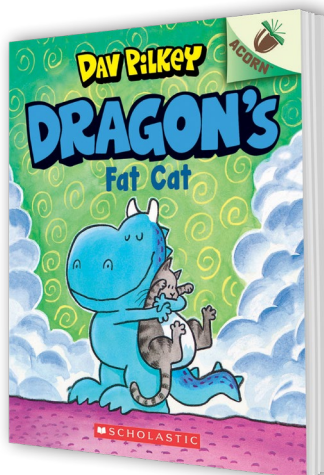

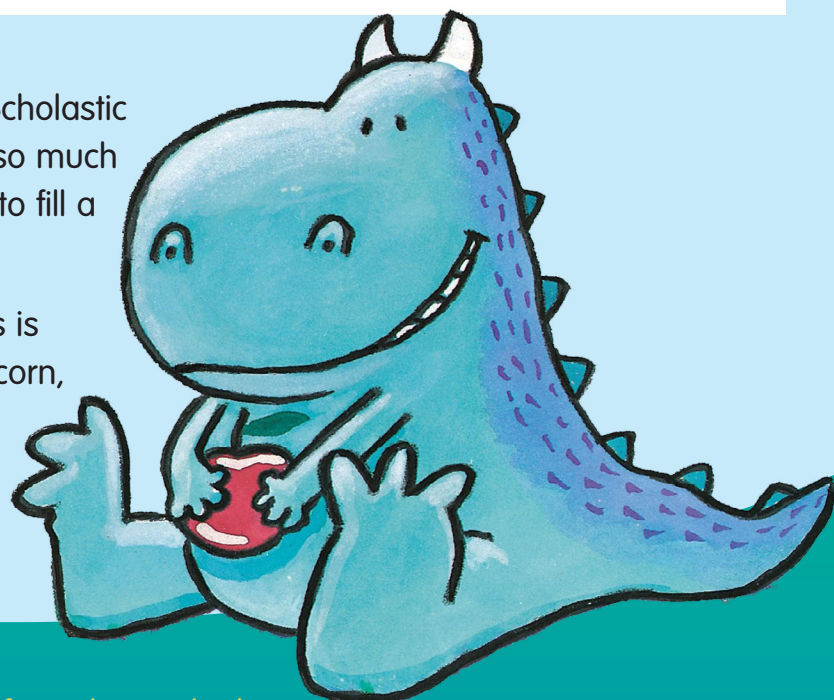
