DIY YOUR PARTY! PAPER-CHAIN CURTAIN

Make a fun, simple wall hanging that works as a decoration or photo backdrop.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- · Glue, sticky tape, or a stapler
- Long stick
- · String, wire, or hooks



GET STARTED

- 1. To make a 3 foot by 4 foot paper-chain curtain, cut your paper into strips that are 1 to 1-1/2 inches wide and 6 to 8 inches tall.

 When you have two strips ready,
- 2. Make the first loop of a chain: Take one strip of paper and curl it into a loop so the two ends meet. Glue, tape, or staple

the ends together so that one strip

makes a circle.

move on to step 2.

3. Feed your second strip of paper through the middle of the loop you just made. Curl the new strip into a loop so the two ends meet.
Connect the ends. You have completed the first two loops of your first chain!



- 4. Cut more strips. Repeat step 3 until you have a long chain of about 20 paper loops. Then you have completed your first chain!
- 5. Make more chains! Try to make at least 10 paper chains. The chains can be different lengths, colors, and sizes. Be creative!
- 6. Once all your chains are ready, slide the first loop of each chain onto the long stick. This will create a curtain of paper chains.



PARTY TIME
