




List 1: Five Beloved Classics




<u>I Love You Through and Through</u> by Bernadette Rossetti-Shustak with illustrations by Caroline Jayne Church


<u>I Love You, Stinky Face</u> by Lisa McCourt with illustrations by Cyd Moore
