SNAP



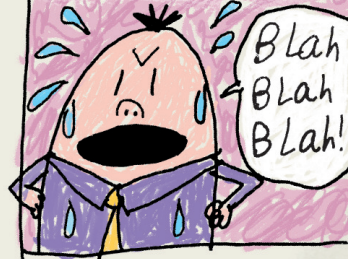
...he turns into Captain Underpants.



and whenever Captain Underpants gets water on his head....

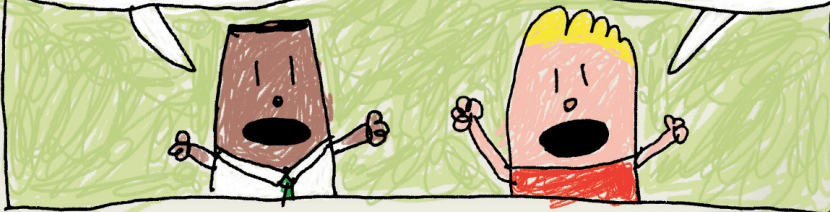

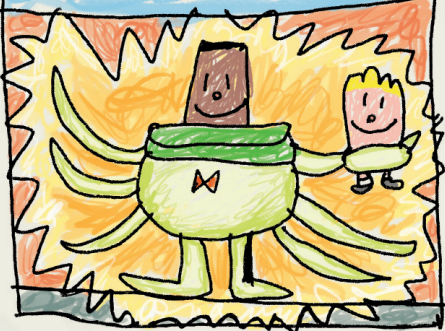


One Day George and Harold had a really **BIG** Problem.

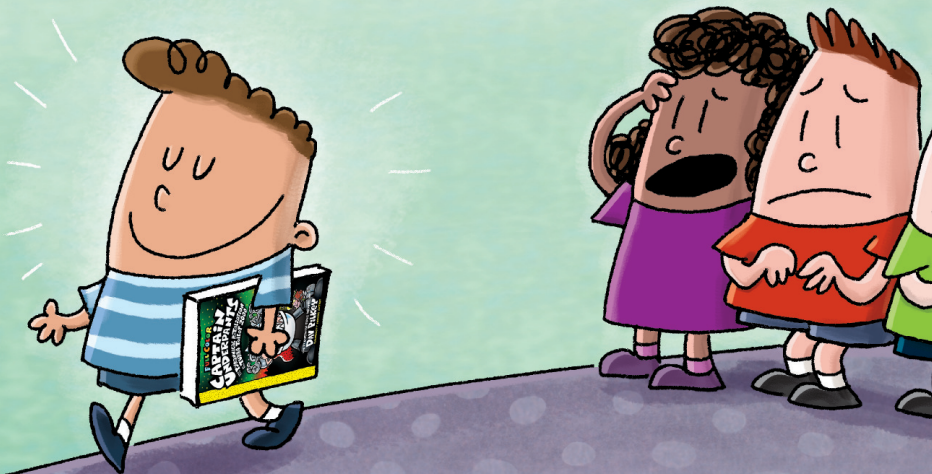


CHAPTER 2

If you *didn't* read our last adventure, you're probably scratching your head and saying to yourself, "Hey, myself, what the heck is going on here?"

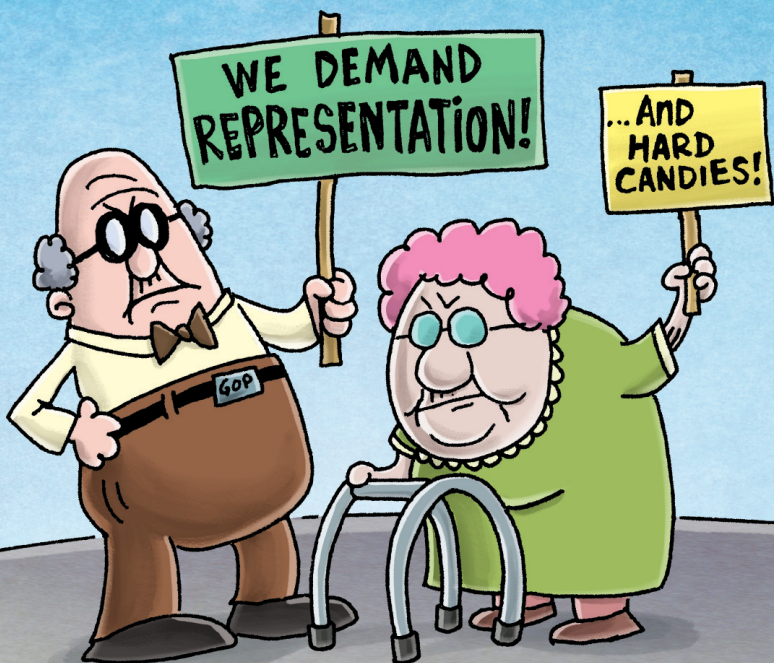

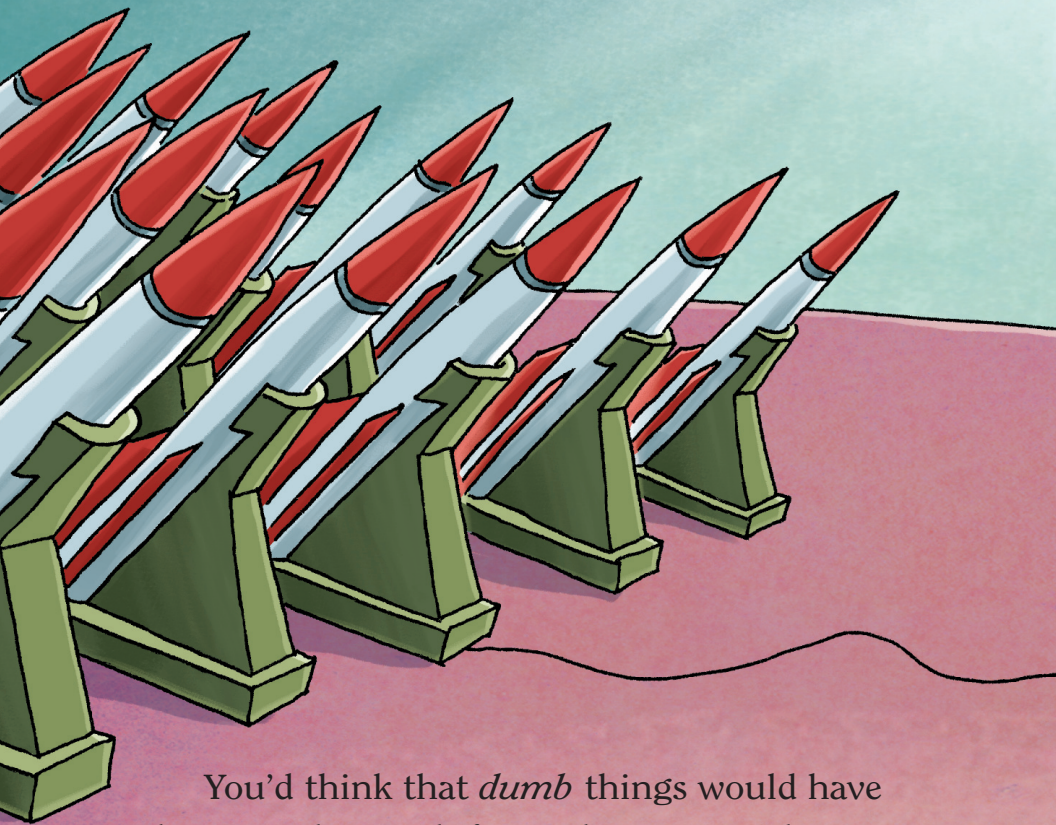

THE SPECIES WHO KNEW TOO MUCH

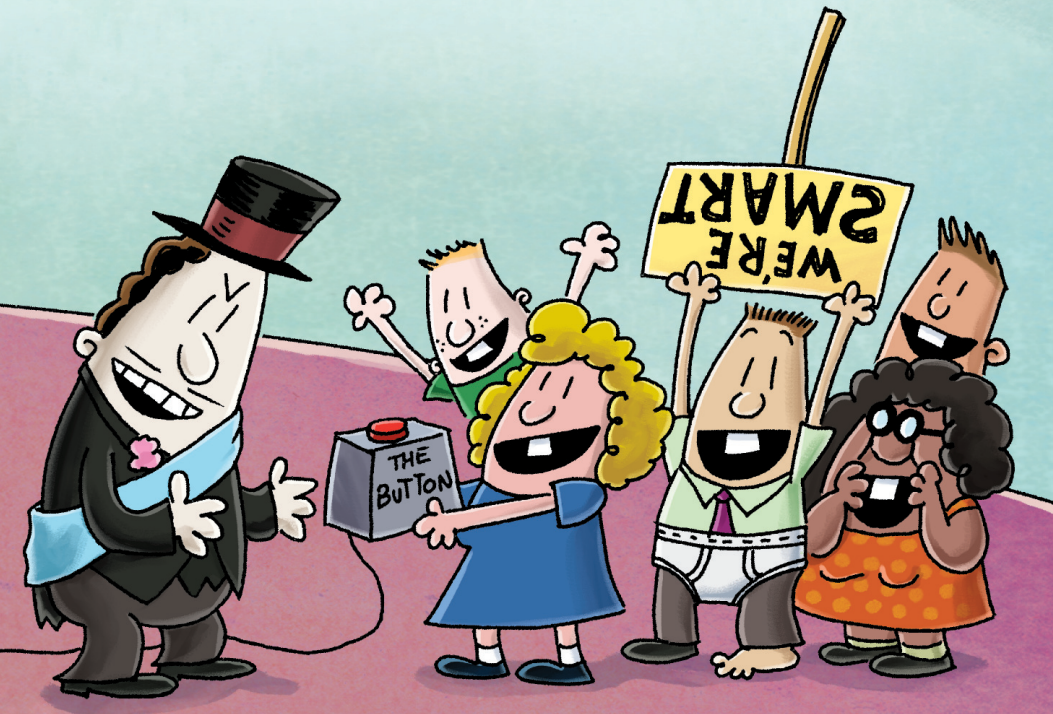

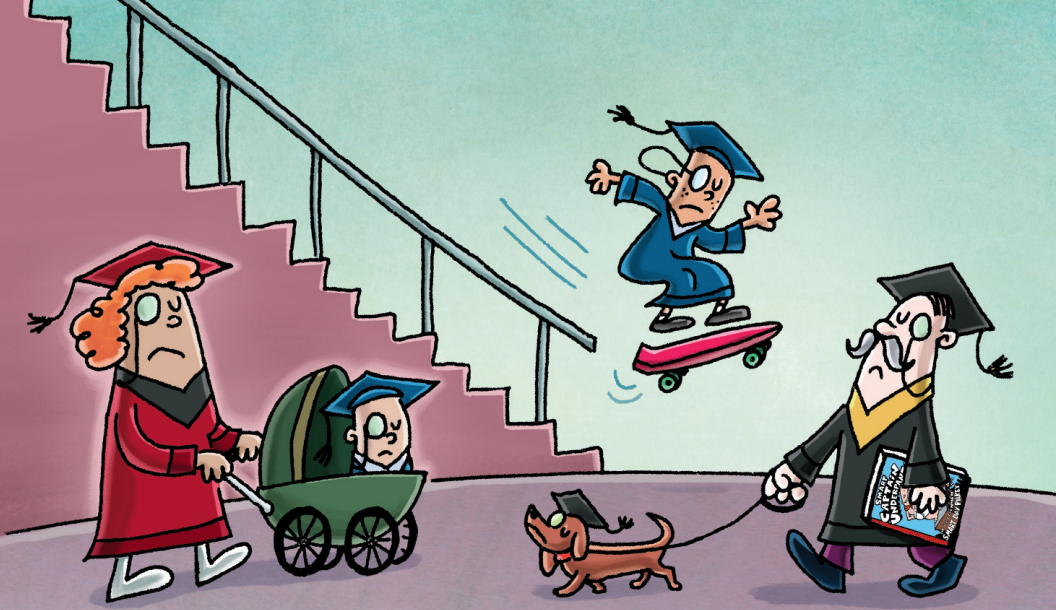
CHAPTER 4

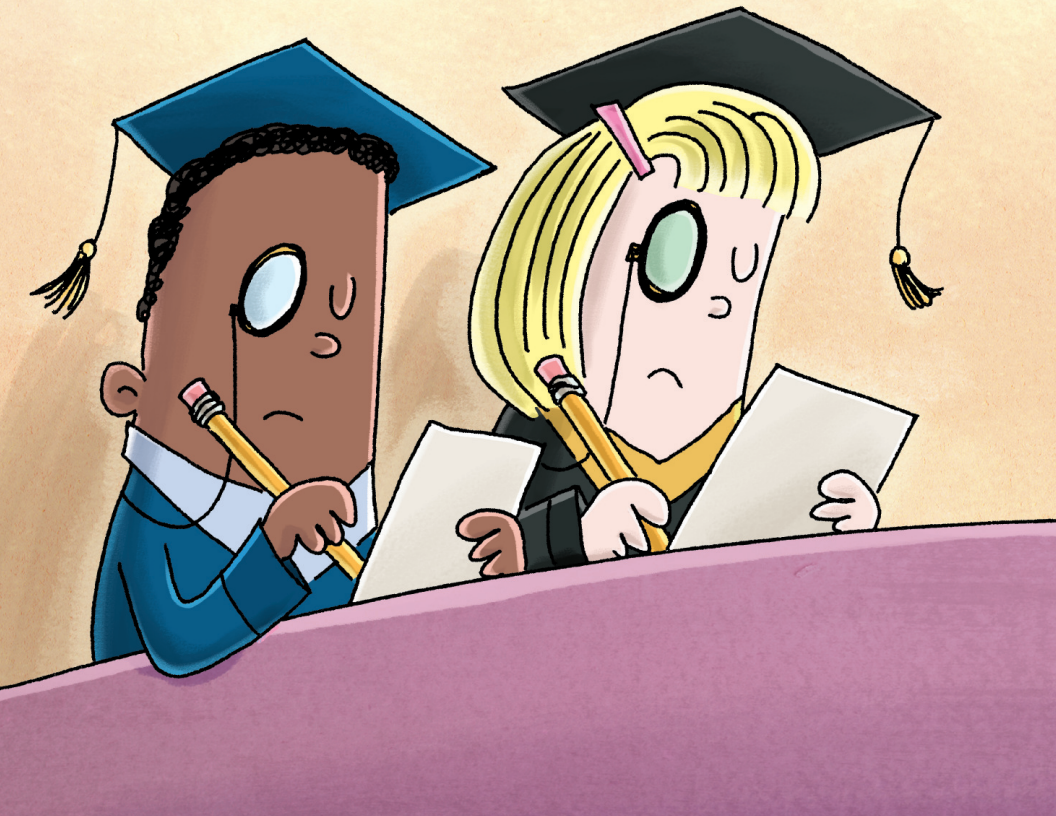
