

He walked through the crunchy snow.


He saw all sorts of trees . . . big ones, small ones, crooked ones, and straight ones.

It was not too big, or too small. It was not too crooked, or too straight. It was just right.






He looked up and saw its beautiful green branches. They waved back and forth in the cold December wind.
